- In Class: Personal Finance, Consumer Ed, Economics
- Homeroom: advisory period or w/ counselors
- Summer Programs: small group or one-on-one work
- Capstone project: present post high school plan
- Lesson Timeline:
  - o < 2 min to create accounts, 15-20 minutes per 'path'</p>
  - ~45 to 60 min lesson, periodic check-ins and discussions
  - Students accounts are available forever
