Your student will have the chance to participate in a program called Money Sense during one of their regular classes. The program is offered through our nonprofit, SecureFutures. Thousands of high school students like yours will participate in one of our programs this school year.

Our programs teach teens about financial skills. Your student will learn about budgeting, saving for the future, managing bank accounts and other important financial concepts. They will learn through hands-on activities and group discussion.

To make sure our lessons are helpful, we survey students. Your student will be asked to share what and how much they learned and whether they enjoyed the lessons in these surveys. The surveys will take place during class time. They will take no more than 5 minutes each.

We do not collect any information that can identify your student. These surveys are used to make sure our program is useful and impactful.

Participation in the lessons and surveys is voluntary. Students may take the lessons, but skip the surveys. Please notify your student's teacher if you do not want them to participate in the lessons or the surveys.
