



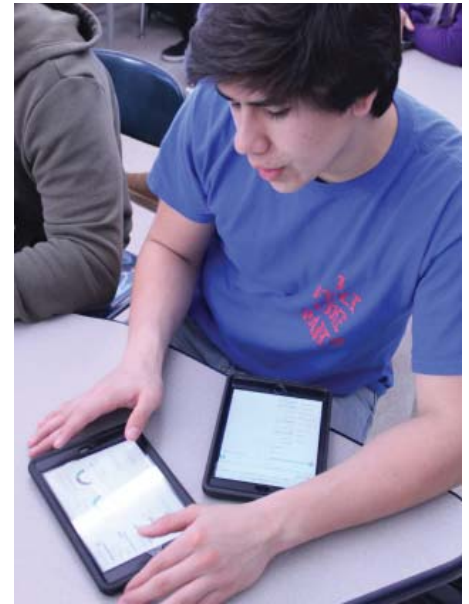
SecureFutures Money Path
