We're excited to announce that your teen will be participating in [Money Path](#), a cutting-edge financial education program that enables teens to explore how their decisions about college, career, budgeting, and saving will impact their long-term goals and financial success.

The program is offered through SecureFutures, a nonprofit organization we partner with. Thousands of teens like yours will participate in one of their programs this year.

Students will be setting up their personal account on the SecureFutures Money Path App. It is a secure site. They will enter their name and either a school or personal email to set up their account and then create a password.

SecureFutures does not share this information with anyone, nor do they market any products. Your student may receive an email in the future notifying them about enhancements to the Money Path App or to other free financial tools they can utilize. Students will make decisions throughout the app related to their plans after high school, but will not enter any personal or private information into the App. They will continue to have ongoing access to the App to help them develop their post-high school financial plan.
