



Dear parent/guardian,

Your teen will have the chance to participate in a program called Money Sense through a local, community organization they are involved with. The program is offered through our nonprofit, SecureFutures. Thousands of teens like yours will participate in one of our programs this year.

Our programs teach teens about financial skills. They will learn about budgeting, saving for the future, managing bank accounts and other important financial concepts. They will learn through hands-on activities and group discussion.

To make sure our lessons are helpful, we survey participants. Your teen will be asked to share what and how much they learned and whether they enjoyed the lessons in these surveys. The surveys will take place during program time. They will take no more than 5 minutes each.

We do not collect any information that can identify your teen. These surveys are used to make sure our program is useful and impactful.

Participation in the lessons and surveys is voluntary. Teens may take the lessons, but skip the surveys. Please notify the partner organization's program coordinator if you do not want them to participate in the lessons or the surveys.
