



Dear parent/guardian,

We're excited to announce that your student will be participating in [Money Path](#), a cutting-edge financial education platform that enables teens to explore how their decisions about college, career, budgeting and saving will impact their long-term goals and financial success.

The program is offered through SecureFutures, a nonprofit organization we partner with. Thousands of high school students like yours will participate in one of their programs this school year.

Students will be setting up their personal account on the SecureFutures Money Path App. It is a secure site. They will enter their name and either a school or personal email to set up their account and then create a password.

SecureFutures does not share this information with anyone nor do they market any products. Students will make decisions throughout the app related to their plans after high school, but will not enter any personal or private information into the app. They will continue to have ongoing access to the app to help them develop their post-high school financial plan. Your student may receive an email in the future notifying them about enhancements to the Money Path app or to other free financial tools they can have access to.

Before or after the lesson, your student may ask you questions about your household finances if they are considering attending college. This information will be used to help them estimate their potential student loan debt and will not be used for any other reason. The information will remain confidential to their personal account.
