





## Financially Fearless 2022 – How to become a fundraiser

Please follow the instructions below to set up your personalized fundraiser page through our peer-to-peer fundraising platform, Give Lively. ### Creating a personalized fundraising account

- 1) Navigate to the [Financially Fearless campaign page](#).
- 2) Click on "I Want To Fundraiser For This."



- 3) If you do not already have an account in Give Lively, fill in your name and email address and choose a password, then click "Submit" to create your account. Follow the instructions to confirm your email address, then log in to continue the process of setting up your personalized fundraising page.
- 4) If you already have an account in Give Lively, click "Confirm Creation Of Your Fundraising Page."
- 5) On the "Personalize Your Page" screen, upload a photo if you choose.


8) Click the blue "Save" button. Your personalized fundraiser page is now complete!

## Sharing your fundraiser

1) To share your fundraiser on social media, click the “Share This Page” button on your fundraiser page.



2) Select the link to the social media platform on which you'd like to share. You'll need to be logged into whatever platform you choose.



3) Add a personal message to your post, or use any of the social media post templates we provide. We recommend posting weekly throughout the month.

4) To share the campaign with your network via email, click “Copy Link” and paste that link into the email. You can use the email template we provide or write your own.
