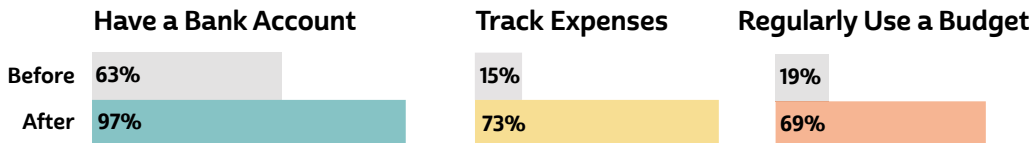
Money Coach
